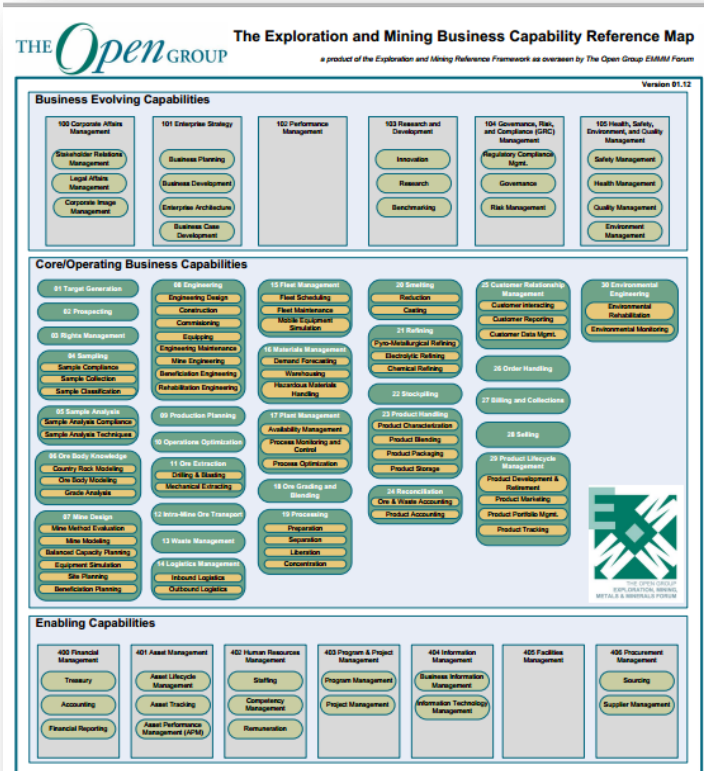

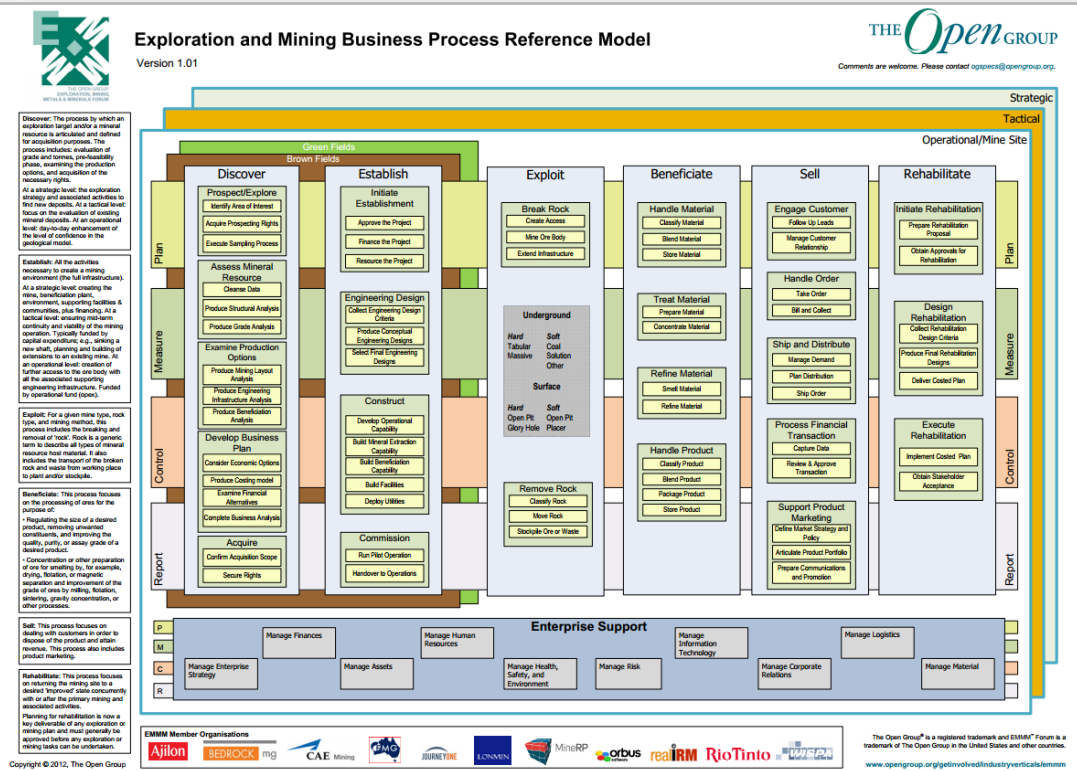
The EM Framework defines a reference for concepts within exploration and mining. This Business Capability Reference Map is the second deliverable of the framework, for all metals and minerals.

Business Capability: A Business Capability refers to the ability to achieve a specific business outcome encompassing People, Process, Technology, and Information. It describes what a company is required to do but defines no detail about how to achieve it.

Enterprise Security Architecture for Cyber Security

Cyber Security is one of the major challenges facing organisations within all industries.
